Surfing is about converting a fairly big pond of saltwater into a proper racetrack. Sounds like magic, but really it's only about physics. All it takes is speed. Speed can be generated in various ways, leading to various ways to qualify speed: explosive speed, rocket speed, etc. Be it made of plastic so you can surf anywhere carelessly, or of the finest carbon/

kevlar composite mix so you can save a maximum of weight, with a low back rocker and sharp rails a Riot surf kayak is an excellent way to generate speed. Nevertheless, saying "Riot speed" would just be redundant.
